

POOL INSPECTION CHECKLIST (NSW)

Pools Built/Installed Before 01/09/2008

| Is your pool or boundary fence at least 1200mm high all the way around the pool area? | Yes | No |
| Are the gaps between the bottom of the fence and the ground no greater than 100mm? | Yes | No |
| No potential hand holds or foot holds within 900mm of the top of the pool fence in any direction? | Yes | No |
| Are the gaps between the pool fence vertical rails or bars no greater than 100mm apart? | Yes | No |
| If your pool fence has mesh or perforated material, are the holes no greater than 13mm? | Yes | No |
| Is your pool fence in good repair and fixed securely, with no damages? | Yes | No |

| Does the pool gate open outwards away from the pool? | Yes | No |
| Does the pool gate self-close and self-latch from all open positions? The gate latch must be working well so that the gate is secure and, once closed, can't be pulled open. | Yes | No |
| If gate latch is on the outside, is the latch lever at least 1500mm above ground level? | Yes | No |
| If gate latch is on the inside, is the latch lever at least 1200mm above ground level and at least 150mm below the top of the gate? | Yes | No |
| Are you aware that it is dangerous and against the law to prop the gate open? | Yes | No |

| No climbable objects within 900mm on the outside and 300mm on the inside? | Yes | No |
| Is there a compliant CPR sign which can be easily read from a distance of 3 metres? | Yes | No |
| If a wall forms part of the barrier, there are no openings greater than 100mm? | Yes | No |
| Windows in the pool area fitted with security screens or open no greater than 100mm? | Yes | No |
| Your pool fence must be clear of any objects such as BBQs, trees, rocks, shrubs and deckchairs that could help a small child climb over the fence? | Yes | No |
